Mutual of Omaha Employees to Build Habitat for Humanity House in Omaha

This summer, hundreds of Mutual of Omaha employees will trade in their desks and computers for hammers and saws as the company sponsors the construction of a Habitat for Humanity house located at 3114 Decatur St. in Omaha.

Approximately 15 employees will kick-off the company-wide volunteer effort as they begin laying the framework for the house this **Thursday, May 4, from 12:30 to 4 p.m.**

This year's effort marks only the second time Mutual of Omaha has donated both the startup costs and the volunteers needed to build a Habitat for Humanity house. Last year, more than 600 employees dedicated nearly 2,000 hours to build a house for a local Omaha family.
